School Counseling Program – Student Outcomes:
Academic Year 2021-2022

The Rutgers Graduate School of Education (GSE) school counseling program had eight graduates in the 2021-2022 academic year (May 2022), which included seven students who began in fall 2020 and one student who began in fall 2019.

Of the eight students who began full-time in fall 2020, seven graduated in May 2022 for a completion rate of 88%. One student transferred to another program at Rutgers GSE. One part-time student who began in fall 2020 is on track to graduate in May 2023.

All May 2022 graduates earned their state license, and no examination is required in New Jersey or by Rutgers.

One May 2022 graduate is employed in a different area and not seeking a position in school counseling, while the remaining seven graduates (88%) secured employment in counseling following completion of the program. Six are working as school counselors while one is working at a counseling center.
