#### **Evelyn Headley Award for Outstanding Dissertation**

Evelyn Headley had a long career in education and was a leader in the Edison Township School District. She received the Distinguished Service Award from the GSEAA in 1964. Dr. Headley was a member of the Rutgers University Board of Trustees at the time of her death in 1985.

#### 2023 DISTINGUISHED LEADER IN EDUCATION

### Dr. Jonathan Holloway

President, Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey University Professor and Distinguished Professor

Jonathan Holloway, a U.S. historian, took office as the 21st president of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, on July 1, 2020. He also serves as a University Professor and Distinguished Professor.

Prior to accepting the presidency of Rutgers, Dr. Holloway was provost of Northwestern University from 2017 to 2020 and a member of the faculty of Yale University from 1999 to 2017. At Yale, he served as Dean of Yale College and the Edmund S. Morgan Professor of African American Studies, History, and American Studies.

President Holloway's scholarly work specializes in post-emancipation U.S. history with a focus on social and intellectual history.

He is the author of African American History: A Very Short Introduction and The Cause of Freedom: A Concise History of African Americans (Oxford University Press, February 2023 and February 2021, respectively). He also published Confronting the Veil: Abram Harris Jr., E. Franklin Frazier, and Ralph Bunche, 1919-1941 (2002), and Jim Crow Wisdom: Memory and Identity in Black America Since 1940 (2013), both with the University of North Carolina Press. He edited Ralph Bunche's A Brief and Tentative Analysis of Negro Leadership (New York University Press, 2005) and coedited Black Scholars on the Line: Race, Social Science, and American Thought in the Twentieth Century (Notre Dame University Press, 2007). He wrote the introduction for the 2015 edition of W.E.B. Du Bois's Souls of Black Folk (Yale University Press), and is working on a new book, A History of Absence: Race and the Making of the Modern World.

Dr. Holloway, who began his academic career at the University of California, San Diego, received a bachelor's degree with honors in American studies from Stanford University and a Ph.D. in history from Yale University.

He serves on boards of the Smithsonian's National Museum of African American History and Culture, the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, the Gates Cambridge Trust, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the Universities Research Association, the Institute of International Education, and the Academic Leadership Institute.

Dr. Holloway is an elected member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and the Society of American Historians. He is a Fellow of the Council on Foreign Relations

He is married to Aisling Colón. They have a daughter, Emerson, and son, Ellison.

The GSE offers over 60 different programs of study, including Ph.D., Ed.D., master's, and non-degree programs. These programs activate learning and teaching. Whether students enroll in advanced degree or certification tracks, they receive lively, relevant instruction from top experts and are immersed in multimodal coursework.

Since its inception in 1923, the GSE has prepared effective practitioners, transformative leaders, and accomplished researchers to create opportunity for all learners. We are proud to have more than 17,000 living alumni and to have produced more than 150 superintendents and 20 college and university presidents. Our graduates preside in leadership roles at the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) and in other government agencies. According to NJDOE, GSE alumni have one of the highest rates of employment in New Jersey school districts. The GSE's guiding principle, "Advancing Excellence and Equity in Education," is realized through its reflective programs, Centers, and Institutes such as its Urban Social Justice Teacher Education Program, which fosters excellence, equity, and social justice in teaching practice; the Hip Hop Youth Research and Activism Program which recruits civically engaged youth to co-organize an annual conference focused on youth culture, youth literacies, art, activism, and social justice; The Rutgers Center for Minority Serving Institutions which focuses on amplifying the important work of Minority Serving Institutions in New Jersey and nationally; and The Samuel DeWitt Proctor Institute for Leadership, Equity, & Justice which works to provide a deeper understanding of equity, justice, and leadership.

Further, our Centers and Institutes utilize findings and research conducted by GSE's faculty to help educators improve policies and practices. These also include the National Institute for Early Education Research, the Robert B. Davis Institute for Learning, the Center for Effective School Practices, and the Center for Literacy Development.
