

Educating for Excellence & Equity Symposium: Teachers Who Transform



The Educating for Excellence & Equity Symposium is the culminating experience of the Excellence and Equity in Education Fellowship, which brought together a cohort of pre-service teachers committed to equity-centered, justice-oriented, and leadership-driven practice in PK–12 public schools.

Throughout the 2025–26 academic year, fellows engaged in monthly learning sessions focused on key themes including classroom culture and school community, excellent and equitable teaching, and reflective, evolving practice. The symposium is designed to extend this work outward by creating a space for all GSE pre-service teachers to engage with these ideas through practitioner leadership, dialogue, and shared inquiry.

The symposium will feature keynote addresses by **Dr. Bettina Love** and **Dr. Yolanda Sealey-Ruiz**, and breakout workshops led by community and school-based education leaders. These sessions are designed to connect theory to practice and to foreground equity and justice as lived, enacted, and collective professional work.
