

Why Does Aeromexico Block Name Change on Existing Ticket™ [2026 Policy Answer]

Aeromexico blocks full name changes on existing tickets because the booking record ties to a specific passenger identity verified at booking and tracked through APIS immigration pre-screening, airport security screening (TSA Secure Flight or equivalent), and boarding-pass identity matching at the gate.
