- **Fare Difference:** If the new flight you select is more expensive than your original ticket, you will be required to pay the difference in fare. If the new flight is cheaper, the remaining value (minus any applicable fees for Basic Economy) will typically be issued as an eCredit [3].
- **Basic Economy Tickets:** Basic Economy tickets generally have stricter rules. While some may be changeable for a fee plus any fare difference, others might have no remaining value if not changed or canceled prior to departure .
- **International Travel (Outside U.S., Canada, Caribbean):** For tickets originating outside these regions, a change fee of \$0-\$400 may apply, depending on the origin location and the type of fare .
- **Award Tickets:** Change fees for Award Tickets have also been eliminated for travel within the U.S. (including Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands) and for international travel originating in the United States and Canada. Changes can be made any time prior to departure .

How to Change Your Flight by Phone

While online options are available, contacting Delta by phone ensures you can speak directly with a representative who can guide you through complex changes, explain policies, and help find the best alternatives. This is especially useful for intricate itineraries or when dealing with specific circumstances.

Steps to Change Your Flight via Phone:

1. **Gather Your Information:** Before calling, have your 6-digit confirmation number, ticket number (starts with 006), and SkyMiles number ready. This will expedite the process .
2. **Call the Appropriate Number:**
 - For general inquiries and reservations: 🇺🇸 +1-(866)-(332)-0756 .
 - For SkyMiles members: 🇺🇸 +1 / 866 / 332 / 0756 .
 - For international calls, use the general international number:
+1-800-241-4141 .
3. **Explain Your Request:** Clearly state that you wish to change your flight and provide your current flight details and desired new travel plans.
4. **Inquire About Fees and Fare Differences:** The agent will inform you of any applicable fare differences or fees based on your ticket type and the changes you wish to make.
5. **Confirm Changes:** Once you agree to the changes and any associated costs, the agent will process the modification and send you a new confirmation.

Same-Day Flight Changes

Delta offers options for same-day flight changes, providing flexibility for travelers. These changes are typically available within 24 hours of your original scheduled departure time.

- **Same-Day Confirmed:** For a fee (often \$75, but waived for certain Medallion members and ticket types), you can confirm a seat on an earlier or later flight on the same day, provided there is availability [2].
- **Same-Day Standby:** Delta allows free standby for an earlier, alternative flight on the day of departure, starting August 4, 2021 [4]. This option is subject to seat availability and does not guarantee a confirmed seat.

It is highly recommended to call Delta's customer service to inquire about same-day change options, as availability and specific rules can vary.

Important Considerations and Tips for Phone Contact

- **Best Time to Call:** To minimize wait times, consider calling Delta's customer service on Tuesdays or Wednesdays during morning hours. Avoid calling during major weather events or holidays, as call volumes will be significantly higher [5].
