

Can I Still Reschedule My United Flight at the Airport Kiosk?

Why the United Airlines Website and App Block Flight Change Requests

When the United Airlines website or app returns an error during a flight change, reschedule, modification, edit, upgrade, re-issue, or itinerary update — the system has encountered a conflict it cannot resolve automatically. These errors are not always caused by the passenger's action. They can be triggered by real-time fare class conflicts, session timeouts, payment gateway failures, or post-check-in system locks that prevent further changes through the self-service tool. Understanding why these blocks occur helps determine the fastest path to completing the modification.

- **Online Error During Flight Change or Reschedule:** When a change or reschedule request is submitted through the United Airlines manage trips portal and the system returns an error, the modification has not been saved — the original itinerary remains active. The error is most commonly caused by a fare class availability conflict where the new flight no longer has inventory in the same fare class as the original booking, or by a session timeout that invalidates the transaction before it completes.
