

Why Is United Charging a Reschedule Fee on a Basic Economy Ticket?

Same-day departure time reschedules on United Airlines are evaluated at 📞 +1-877-641-(2470). Eligible fare classes and SkyMiles Medallion tiers may qualify for complimentary same-day time changes, while other ticket types require a fare difference payment based on the new time slot pricing. Agents verify your rescheduling eligibility, search open departures on your route, and process the time switch with any applicable fare adjustment or status-based waiver applied before confirmation. Completed time reschedules issue an updated boarding pass with new departure details and gate assignment for your revised flight.

Same-day rescheduling fee structures on United Airlines differ from advance change fee schedules, with same-day modifications to earlier or later departures carrying reduced charges compared to date changes made days or weeks before travel. Loyalty program members may qualify for complimentary same-day rescheduling that waives both the modification fee and any applicable fare difference.

United Airlines Change Fee, Modification Policy, and Re-Issue Rules

United Airlines's change fee and modification policy determines whether a passenger pays a fee to change, reschedule, modify, edit, or upgrade a flight, and whether a ticket re-issue is required after the modification is applied. The policy varies by fare class, route, and the type of modification requested. Understanding which fees apply — and which can be waived — before initiating a change prevents unexpected charges and ensures the modification is processed correctly the first time.

- **Change and Reschedule Fees by Fare Class: Most United Airlines Main Cabin, Comfort+, First Class, and Business Class tickets are eligible for fee-free changes and reschedules — the passenger is responsible only for any fare difference between the original and new flight. Basic Economy fares are generally not eligible for changes or reschedules under any circumstance. If an unexpected change fee appears at checkout for a fare class that should be fee-free, the policy may not have been correctly applied. - **Modification and Edit Policy — Fare Difference Rules: United Airlines modifications and edits are subject to the fare difference between the original ticket and the new flight at the time of the change. If the new flight costs less, the difference is typically issued as a travel credit rather than a cash refund depending on the fare type. The modification policy does not waive the fare difference — only the change fee. - **Upgrade Fee and Policy — When Fees Apply: Paid upgrades on United Airlines to First Class, Business Class, Polaris, or Delta One carry a fee based on the fare difference between the original cabin and the upgraded cabin at the time of the request. Upgrade fees paid using PlusPoints or upgrade certificates follow a different structure and may not involve a cash payment. Upgrade fees are generally non-**

- **Re-Issue — When a New E-Ticket is Required:** A ticket re-issue on United Airlines generates a new e-ticket number to reflect changes to the flight, date, destination, name, seat, or cabin class.
