

# LATAM Cancel Flight and Refund Processing

Cancel flight and refund processing on LATAM are handled at ☎ **+1-((833))-744-((0664))** through the backend reservation system with full access to refund routing options. Each step operates with manual authority that allows agents to override fare class restrictions, apply waiver provisions, and process complex scenarios that consumer interfaces cannot handle through automated workflows.

### Request Intake and Eligibility Verification

Request intake on LATAM direct cancellation processing begins with passenger identity verification, booking lookup through expanded identifier support, and initial authorization based on the requested transaction type.
